Super Bowl of Golf Rules

Tournament Format for Super Bowl of Golf teams only: Five-some scramble with a shotgun start.

Celebrity Captains: Are responsible for making sure the team understands the scramble method of play; selecting the best positioned ball after each shot throughout the tournament; taking the scorecard to the scorekeeper to mark one score for the team on each hole; and signing and turning in the card immediately upon completion of play.

Team Handicap: The scoring system is based on a team handicap derived by taking the lowest individual handicap in the five-some and multiplying that number by 35 percent. Tournament scoring rules penalize teams for having more than one "A" player (0-8 Handicap) and/or more than two "B" players (9-16 handicap).

Handicap Verification: All winners' handicaps are subject to verification. All decisions of the Tournament Golf Committee on handicapping, penalties, and scoring are final.

Scoring: Will be completed in accordance with the official tournament pairing/scoring formation the NFL Alumni Golf Manual. On the scorecard, only one score is recorded after each hole. The celebrity captain and the official scorer must agree on the score before entering the score on the scorecard. Final scores of each team will be official only when the celebrity captain and official scorekeeper have signed the scorecard.

Shotgun Start: Each SBOG five-some is given a starting hole. If two teams are starting on the same hole, the "A" team will tee off first, followed by the "B" team". If one of your five-some drops out, your team members will alternate taking the fifth shot. Each male team member will originate play from the NFLA designated tee markers while female team members will originate play from the Ladies Tees.

Scramble Format: Best Ball - Play the best positioned ball after all members have hit their tee shots. The captain then determines which shot will be used, the "Best Ball." After the best positioned ball is decided, the ball should be marked with a tee. A Club length will be used as measurement from the marked ball in any direction other than towards the hole. This condition must be maintained throughout each shot. Wherever the ball lands, the next shot must be hit from wherever the ball came to rest. You cannot change the condition of play from the rough to the fairway or vice versa, from the fringe to the green or vice versa, and never from the bunker. If all five shots are in the water, the ball for your next shot will be placed two club lengths from the water, with a one-stroke penalty, not closer to the hole. On the green, when the best ball is chosen, mark the shot with a ball marker. You may choose to position the ball one putter head length to either side of the marker, but may not be closer to the hole.

Do Not Putt Out: Please mark your ball and give all five players a chance to putt from the same distance. If you putt out, that ball will be your official score even if a subsequent putter holes out from the original marker location. Each player is allowed one, and only one mulligan, for eighteen holes.

USGA Rules: All USGA rules are in effect and any rule amendments or changes will be announced prior to the start!

Non Super Bowl of Golf Rotary Benefactor Teams will follow traditional four-person scramble format and participate in survivor ball contest, closest to the pin, longest drive, and hole in one prizes, as well as be included in competition for cash prizes.

2020 SBOG SHOOT-OUT RULES

CLARIFICATION ON DEFINITIONS USED: THE FIVE (5) PLAYERS ON EACH TEAM ARE CALLED PARTNERS AND EACH SET OF PARTNERS IS CALLED A TEAM.

EACH TEAM WILL PLAY ONE BALL FROM THE TEE, THROUGH THE GREEN TO HOLE-OUT FOR EACH HOLE. PARTNERS WILL TAKE TURNS HITTING THE SAME BALL.

ALL USGA RULES ARE IN EFFECT AND ANY RULE AMENDMENTS OR CHANGES WILL BE ANNOUNCED PRIOR TO THE START.

- LOW THREE (3) TEAMS WILL ADVANCE TO THE SBOG SHOOT-OUT
- LOW SCORES ARE DETERMINED BY THE "TEAM FINAL SCORE".
- IF MORE THAN THREE (3) TEAMS QUALIFY BASED ON THE "TEAM FINAL SCORE," THE TOP THREE (3) WILL BE DETERMINED BY MATCH OF CARDS, STARTING ON #1 HANDICAP.
- SHOOT OUT WILL BEGIN ON A HOLE DETERMINED BY ORGANIZERS, TO BE REFERRED TO AS THE "FIRST PLAYOFF HOLE":
- EACH TEAM WILL WRITE THEIR TEAM (CHAPTER) NAME ON THE BALL
- THE FOLLOWING WILL BE THE ORDER IN WHICH EACH TEAM TEE'S OFF FROM THE PLAYOFF HOLE:
 - TEAM WITH THIRD LOWEST SCORE WILL TEE OFF FIRST
 - TEAM WITH SECOND LOWEST SCORE WILL TEE OFF SECOND
 - TEAM WITH LOWEST SCORE WILL TEE OFF THIRD
- EACH TEAM WILL DESIGNATE ONE (1) PLAYER TO HIT THE DRIVE OFF THE FIRST PLAYOFF HOLE AND THEN AN ORDER IN WHICH THE REMAINING FOUR GOLFERS WILL TAKE TURNS HITTING THE SAME BALL.
- EACH TEAM WILL PLAY ONE BALL FROM THE TEE, THROUGH THE GREEN TO HOLE-OUT FOR EACH HOLE
- PARTNERS WILL TAKE TURNS HITTING THE SAME BALL UNTIL THEIR TEAM COMPLETES THE HOLE.
- IF THERE IS A THREE-WAY TIE ON THE PLAYOFF HOLE, THERE WILL BE A CHIP-OFF ON A DESIGNATED PLAYOFF HOLE GREEN TO DETERMINE WHICH TWO (2) TEAMS ADVANCE TO THE FINAL HOLE.
- EACH TEAM WILL THEN DESIGNATE A PLAYER FOR THE CHIP-OFF. THE BALL MUST BE PLACED WITHIN THE DESIGNATED AREA (BETWEEN TWO TEES).
- EACH TEAM WILL HAVE ONE (1) CHIP. THE DESIGNATED PLAYER WILL NOT BE ABLE TO WATCH THE OTHER TEAMS CHIP.
- TEAM WITH THE CLOSEST CHIP WILL ADVANCE (ON FIRST SHOOT-OUT HOLE)
- IF THERE IS A CLEAR WINNER ON THE PLAYOFF HOLE, AND THEN A TWO-WAY TIE, THERE WILL BE A CHIP-OFF ON A DESIGNATED PLAYOFF HOLE GREEN TO DETERMINE WHICH TEAM WILL TAKE SECOND AND THIRD PLACE.
- IF NEEDED, PLAY WILL CONTINUE TO THE SECOND PLAYOFF HOLE WITH THE FINAL TWO (2) TEAMS
- EACH TEAM WILL DESIGNATE ONE PLAYER TO HIT THE DRIVE OFF THE SECOND PLAYOFF HOLE'S TEE BOX; IT MUST BE A DIFFERENT PLAYER THAN THE FIRST PLAYOFF HOLE.
- EACH TEAM WILL PLAY ONE BALL FROM THE TEE, THROUGH THE GREEN TO HOLE-OUT FOR EACH HOLE.
- PARTNERS WILL TAKE TURNS HITTING THE SAME BALL UNTIL THEIR TEAM COMPLETES THE HOLE.
- IF THERE IS A TIE ON THE SECOND PLAYOFF HOLE, THERE WILL BE A CHIP-OFF TO DETERMINE THE CHAMPIONS
- TEAM WITH THE CLOSEST CHIP WILL WIN THE **SUPER BOWL OF GOLF!**
